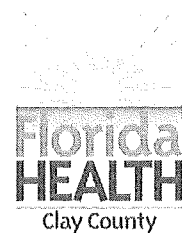
## State of Florida Immunization Requirement Guidelines for school entry for the 2013 - 2014 school year

Immunizations are required prior to entry into any Florida school.\*  
Listed below are the shots needed for the 2013 - 2014 school year.

**PLEASE BRING YOUR SHOT RECORDS WHEN YOU GO TO THE HEALTH DEPT.**  
**Immunizations will not be given without a record of previous shots.** If you need a copy of your child's shot record, it can be obtained from his/her health care provider or school. No appointment is necessary for immunizations at the health department and a parent or guardian must be present to receive services.

<b>Pre Kindergarten</b>	4 DTPs (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis) 3 Polio 4 Hib (Haemophilus Influenzae Type B) 1 MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella) 3 Hepatitis B 1 Varicella (chicken pox)
<b>Kindergarten and Grades 1-6</b>	4 or 5 DTPs (final dose must be given after 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday) 3, 4 or 5 Polio for <b>KG, 1<sup>st</sup> grade</b> (final dose after 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday) 2 MMRs 3 Hepatitis B 2 Varicella for <b>KG and grades 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5</b> 1 Varicella (chicken pox) for <b>grades 6</b>
<b>Grades 7-12</b>	4 or 5 DTPs (final dose must be given after 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday) 3, 4 or 5 Polio (final dose after 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday) 2 MMRs 3 Hepatitis B <b>1 Tdap (grades 7, 8, 9, 10 &amp; 11)</b> 1 Tdap or TD (grade 12) 1 Varicella (chicken pox) for <b>grades 7 through 12</b>

## **SCHOOL HEALTH PARENT INFORMATION REGARDING STUDENT MEDICAL AND/OR MEDICATION NEEDS**

The Clay County School District works in conjunction with the Florida Department of Health in Clay County (DOH Clay) to promote the health and overall well-being of all students. All Clay County schools have at least one nurse in each school. All medications or medical issues will be managed by the parent(s) and each school's nurse to ensure the safety of each child.

A shot record is required for all new students before entry into the school system. The Florida DH 680 form can be obtained from your doctor or from the Health Department. If you do not have a doctor, or are unable to obtain the immunization from your provider, the Health Department offers free vaccinations. For more information, please contact the Bear Run Clinic at (904) 272-3177 for office hours.

A school physical exam is also required for all new students in Florida. It must have been completed within the 12 months immediately preceding the date your child starts school. An out of state physical exam is acceptable provided it contains a review of body systems (head, neck, chest, etc.) and not just a statement that your child is healthy.

All medications must be brought to the school by the parent and the appropriate paperwork needs to be completed. Emergency medications such as Glucagon, Epi-pens and inhalers can be given to the nurse in the clinic or carried on the student, provided the proper documentation has been completed by the parent AND doctor. Extra emergency medication should be left with the nurse for those students who will be carrying their own medications to be used should the student forget to bring his/her medicine. Deliver medications to the school nurse, not the teacher.

Your doctor must complete medical plans for students with chronic diseases such as asthma, cardiac disease, cystic fibrosis, diabetes, seizures or severe allergies and also for any medical procedures which will be performed during the school day. Written instructions regarding your child's medical needs will help make a smoother transition for the upcoming school year.

All medical plans are available from the school nurse during the school year. During the summer months, they can be picked up at the school's main office or downloaded from the Health Department's website at [www.healthyclaycounty.com](http://www.healthyclaycounty.com). (Look under "I need: School Forms"). Please contact your school's nurse directly or the Health Department's School Health Team at (904) 529-2800 regarding your child's medical needs so that a plan of care can be developed with you for the school year.
